Across Five Aprils; R0529

Recorded at a slower than usual pace to make following along with the text easier. This is a story of Jethro Creighton—a nine year old boy who comes of age across the five Aprils of the Civil War. This is also a novel of a mother sending her children off to war, of a wife raising two children on her own, of a young woman facing the prospect of losing the man she loves. Study guide includes reproducible pages of pre and post-reading activities with Cloze, cross-curricular, and writing activities, comprehension questions, graphic organizers, and literary and vocabulary skills. In a chapter-by-chapter format, the guide also provides the teacher with a synopsis, background information, bibliography of related books, and answer key. Reading level: 7.0 Interest level: 6-10 7 hrs. Type: 6 BK/7 CD/TG

Amelia Bedelia; R0591

Amelia Bedelia is a housekeeper whose literal interpretations of her list of chores lead to some extremely funny messes. Reading level: Gr. 2-3, Interest level: Gr. K-4. 18:09 min. Type: 4 BK/CD

Amelia Bedelia Goes Camping; R0589

When Amelia, the mixed-up housekeeper who takes everything literally, goes camping she tries her best to do exactly as she's told. Reading level: Gr. 2-3, Interest level: Gr. K-4. 22:45 min. Type: 4 BK/CD

Bedtime for Frances; R0583

It's bedtime for young Frances—a little badger—and everyone is ready but her. Frances finds it difficult to go to sleep with the strange noises and menacing shapes that seem to fill her room after dark and puts off bedtime as long as possible. Reading level: Gr. 2, Interest level: Gr. K-3. 19:11 min. Type: 4 BK/CD

Ben's Trumpet; R0603

Ben loves to hear the Zig Zag Club musicians play, filling the air with the sounds and rhythms of jazz. And when he hears them, he plays along on a trumpet that nobody else can see — except one man, who opens the door to his dream. Reading level: Gr. 2, Interest level: Gr. PK-3. 6:28 min. Type: 4 BK/CD

Best Friends; R0636

Kathy feels lonely and betrayed when her best friend goes away for the summer and has a wonderful time. A puppy brings the best friends together. Reading level: Gr. 2-5, Interest level: Gr. 1-6. 16:21 min. Type: 4 BK/CD

Birthday for Frances, A; R0581

Tomorrow is Gloria's birthday, and her party is sure to be fun for everyone—except Frances, that is, who wishes it was her own birthday. Reading level: Gr. 2, Interest level: Gr. K-3. 25:42 min. Type: 4 BK/CD

Brad and Jenna Hop, Skip and Jump into Reading; R0700

Sound Reading Emerging interactive first readers guide children through every reading skill. The series contains: See-to-say (rapid naming) practice--the foundation of fluency, Word segmentation and blending practice stories--the key to accurate reading, Word and sentence building activities, and Pyramid and zigzag stories to encourage repeated reading. Book One-The Hop (5 BK), Book Two-The Skip (5 BK), and Book Three-The Jump (5 BK). Type: 15 BK/CD

Case of the Cat's Meow, The; R0575

Snitch and his friends search for Mildred the cat. Reading level: Gr. 1-2, Interest level: Gr. K-3. 21:55 min. Type: 4 BK/CD

Day I Had to Play With My Sister, The; R0543

Older brother thinks he knows the rules to hide-and-peek but little sister has her own idea of how to play. The resulting confusion is compounded by a lively dog. Reading level: Gr. 1, Interest level: Gr. PK-2. 6:33 min. Type: 4 BK/CD

Day Jimmy's Boa Ate the Wash, The; R0640

Young Jimmy decides to bring his pet boa constrictor on a school field trip to the farm. Bedlam erupts, though, when the constrictor decides to socialize with the barnyard animals. Reading level: Gr. 2-5, Interest level: Gr. 1-6. 7:51 min. Type: 4 BK/CD

Eat Up, Gemma; R0541

Recorded by Marie Carbo in short phrases, at a slightly slower than usual pace. Chaos and fun follow little Gemma, who can't be persuaded to eat unless she's ready. Reading level: Gr. 1, Interest level: Gr. PK-2. 9:05 min. Type: 4 BK/CD

Fir Tree, The; R0615

An unhappy little fir tree yearns to grow up, so anxious for greater things, that he cannot appreciate living in the moment. Cut down and used for Christmas, the discontented tree yearns for the past. Reading level: Gr. 6, Interest level: Gr. 3-8. 37:01 min. Type: 5 BK/CD

Frog and Toad are Friends; R0555

Five stories about bravery, dreams, and, most of all, friendship. Reading level: Gr. 1, Interest level: Gr. 1-3. 35:16 min. Type: 3 BK/CD

Good Driving, Amelia Bedelia; R0595
